



Analysis of Feedback 2020-21 Teachers' Feedback:

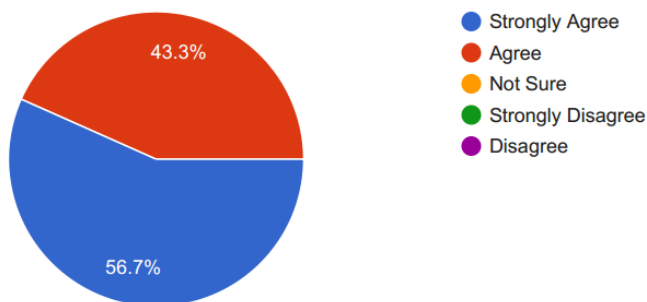

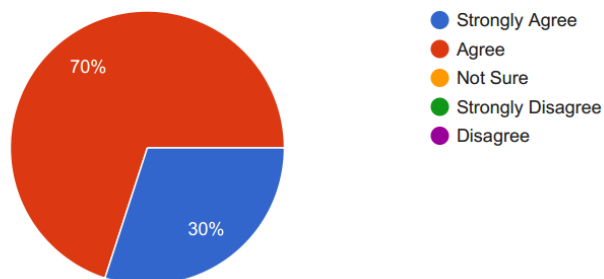


2. Q.2. Syllabus is contemporary and need based?

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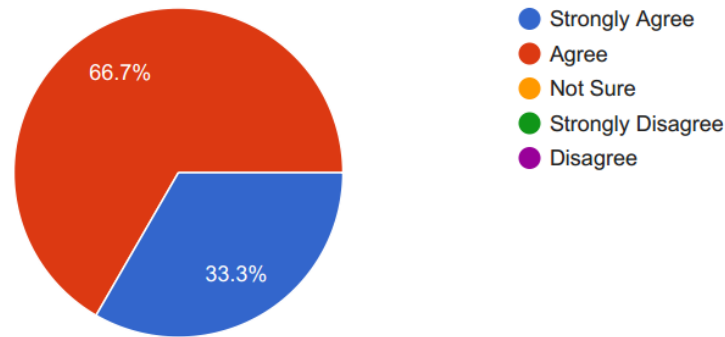
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3. The depth of the course content is adequate to have significant learning outcomes?

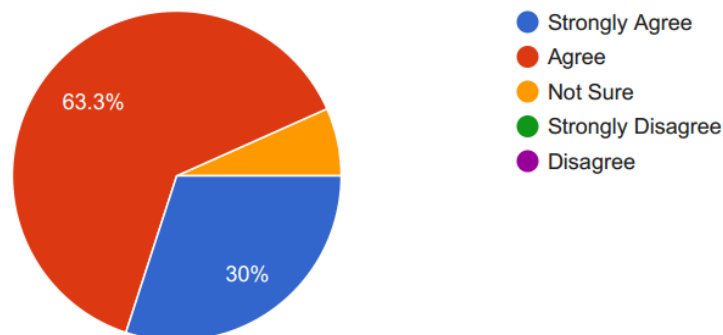


4. Sufficient number of prescribed books on the syllabi are available in the library:

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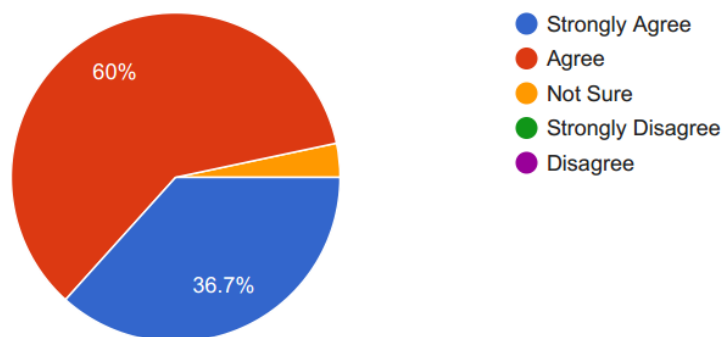
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5. Sufficient reference material and related books and other resources are available for the topics mentioned in the syllabus in the library:

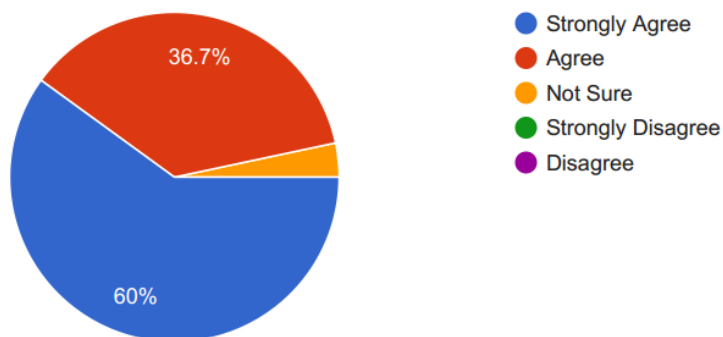
6. The library staff, resource and reading room are effective and accessible?

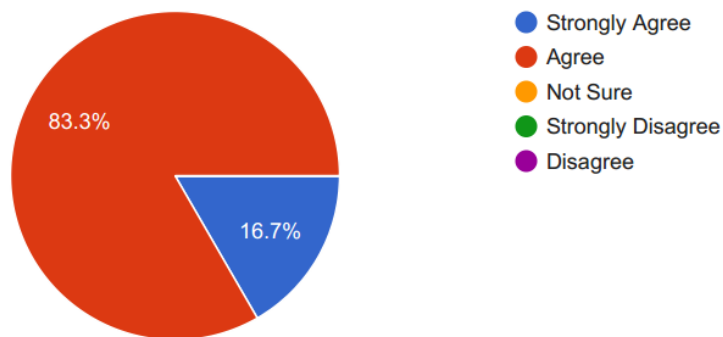


7. The students attain the POs, COs and PSOs satisfactorily.

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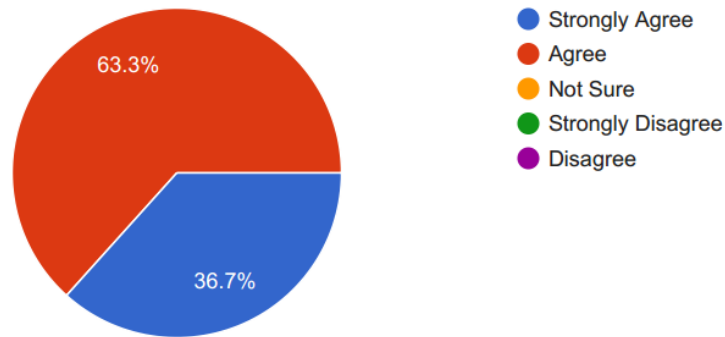

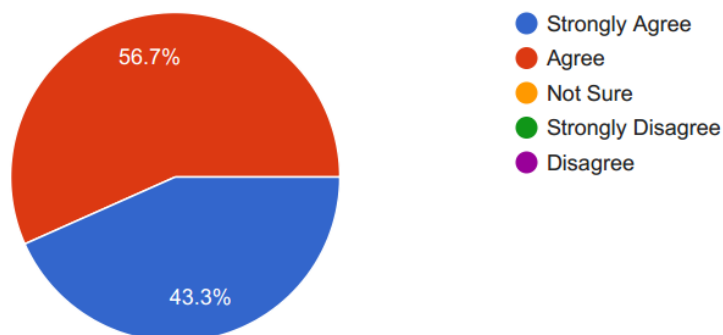
9. Institution academic calendar of events is designed and implemented in adherence to University calendar of events.

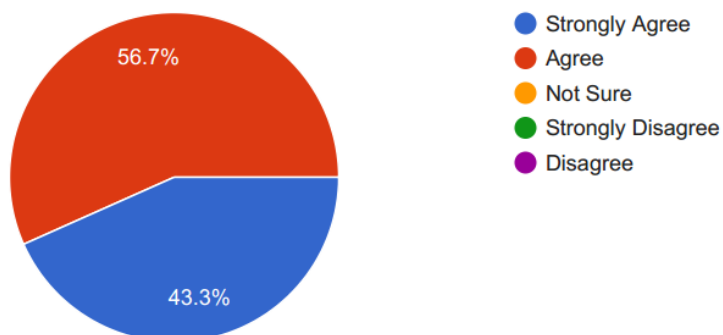


10. The teachers are encouraged to organize / participate in workshops/conferences/ community services/ consultancy services on qualitative themes.

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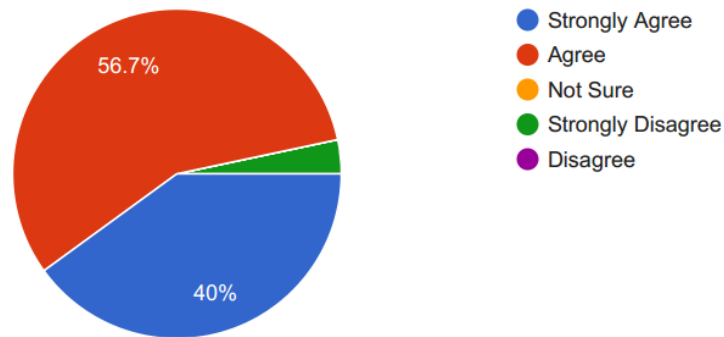

All the teachers were agreed that the sports infrastructure and staff is effective and adequate.



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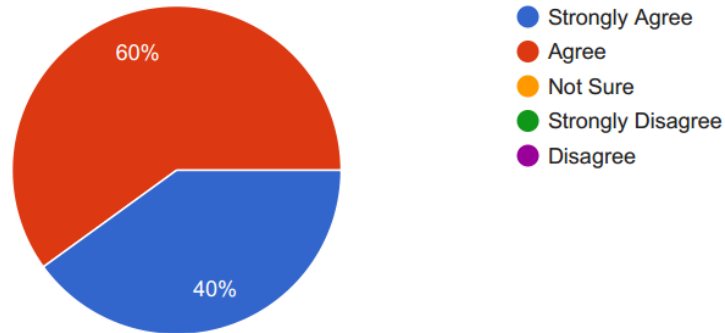

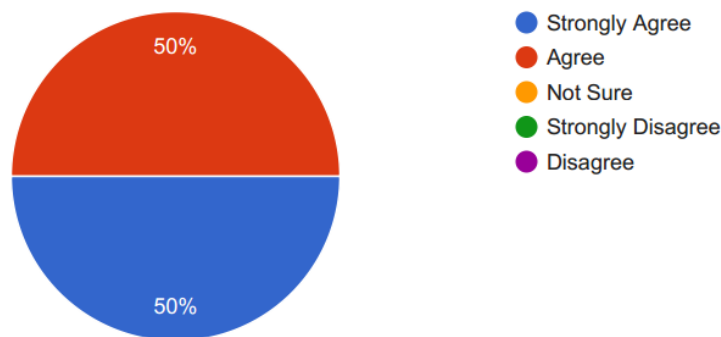


13. The administration is sincerely putting efforts and accessible for the development of the institution.

14. The IQAC is working well for promoting quality to achieve excellence in higher education?



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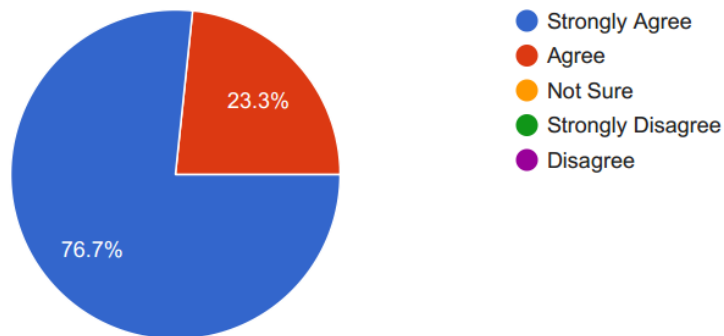
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76.7% teacher's opinion that the IQAC is working well for promoting quality to achieve excellence in higher education.

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
Analysis of Feedback 2020-21 Teachers' Feedback:
