


Analysis of Feedback 2019-20 Students' Feedback:


1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

54 % of the students were of the opinion that they are well prepared for the lecture.






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3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

55% and 27% of the students were of the opinion the teachers approach of teaching was excellent and very good.






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
5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers:

6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?


Students said that usually (54%) assignment performance discussed.






7. The institute takes an active interest in promoting internships, student exchange, and field visit opportunities for students.

8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.


Students opinion was satisfactorily (57%) the teaching and mentoring process carried out in the institute.






9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.


71% of the times teachers inform us our expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.






11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.

12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.


Every time (about 70% students opinion) teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.






13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you by providing the right level of challenges.

14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them? 68% student's opinion that the teachers are identifies our weaknesses and helps us to overcome.






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
15. The institution makes an effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching-learning process.

16. The institute/ teachers use student-centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem-solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.


Students opinion on above point was 61% teachers use student-centric methods.






17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities?

18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work?


68% students replied to institute/teachers inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make us ready for the world of work.






19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.
